

GS NEWS 2022

The COVID ghost continued to influence 2022 and we had fewer exhibitions than in many other years.

August brought an exhibition of creative and collaborative artwork by students from Mother of God PS, Ardeer.

This was followed by an exhibition in September of artwork by students from St Paul's PS, West Sunshine.

In October, Sunshine College combined art and music in a visual arts exhibition with a lively musical opening featuring many of the school's talented musicians

We concluded the year with an exhibition of paper and textile work by students from Sydenham/Hillside PS. An active GSE participant over the years, Sydenham/Hillside PS bookended 2022 with an earlier exhibition in April as well.

In November, we finally implemented the Moonee Valley Council funded (in 2019) Intergenerational Maps Project. Pandemic related lockdowns and demolition of the Flemington Community Hub, proposed location for the Project curtailed earlier implementation of the Project which was finally successfully implemented at Debney Meadows PS in Flemington with coordinator, Dr Iffat Khatoon, artist, Rhiannon Thomas and local historians, Lesley McCarthy and Sheila Byard.
